VETERINARY FACULTY RECEIVES AWARD



A University of Tennessee College of Veterinary Medicine faculty member has been honored by Michigan State University. Dr. Darryl L. Millis has received the Distinguished Postdoctoral Veterinary Alumnus Award from Michigan State University's College of Veterinary Medicine. Dr. Millis was cited for having achieved an international reputation as a researcher, clinician and educator, especially in the field of veterinary physical therapy. "I was humbled when I first learned of the award," Dr. Millis said. "To be considered in the same category as the previous recipients is an honor."

At Tennessee, Dr. Millis' primary interests are arthritic dogs and post-operative rehabilitation as well as physical therapy for chronic joint conditions.

Dr. Millis, associate professor of orthopedics, has been at the veterinary college since 1993.
