Dr. Tom Doherty, MVB, MSc, associate professor of anesthesiology in the Department of Large Animal Clinical Sciences at the University of Tennessee College of Veterinary Medicine, recently returned from England where he presented an abstract to almost 200 veterinary anesthesiologists from Europe, Japan and the United States. Doherty presented “Comparison of Ketamine and Tiletamine-Zolazepam in Xylazine Sedated Horses” at the spring meeting of the Association of Veterinary Anaesthetists (AVA) of Great Britain and Ireland.

Doherty, who has been at the UT College of Veterinary Medicine since 1993, is currently serving a three-year term as vice-president of the World Congress of Veterinary Anesthesia. As vice-president, he is consulting with the organizers of the 9th World Congress of Veterinary Anesthesia which will be held in Brazil in 2006. The 8th WCVA was held in Knoxville last year.
